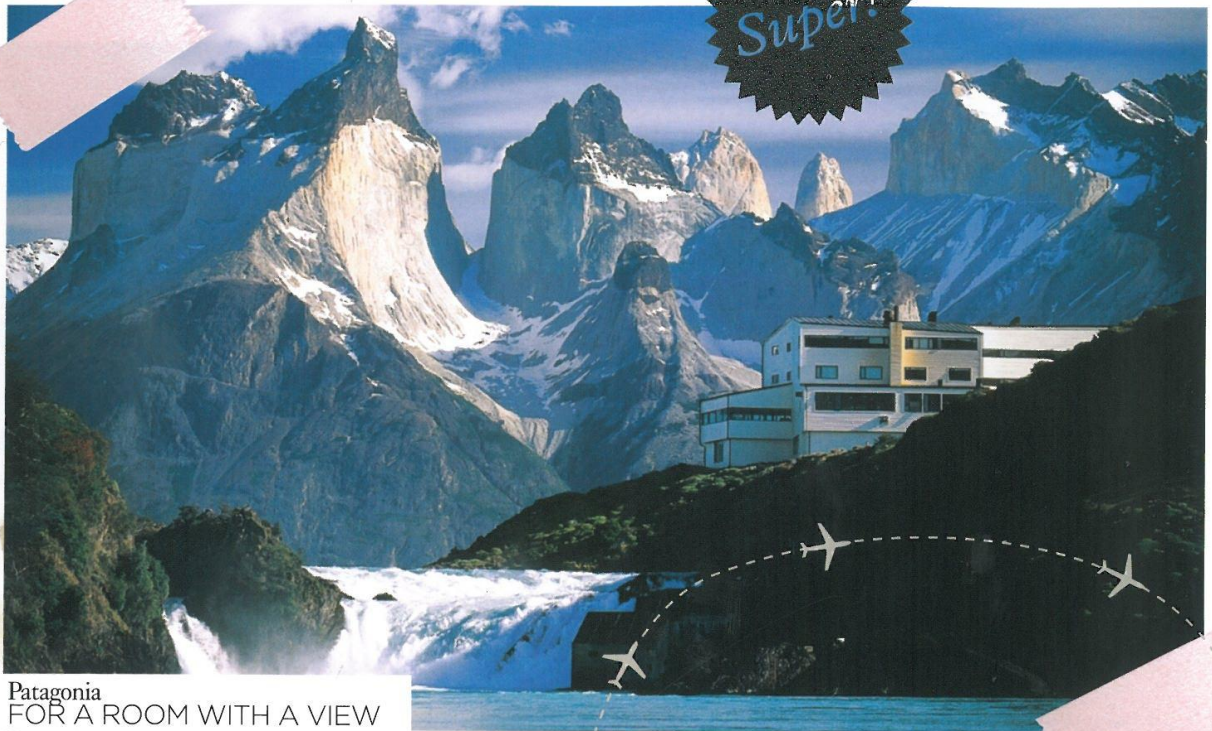

You won't believe your eyes when you see the epic view from your room at the Explora Patagonia Salto Chico lodge, where your window opens onto the tumbling waterfalls and granite towers of the Torres del Paine National Park. If that's not enough to coax you out from between the sheets, the Casa de Baños del Ona with its heated indoor swimming pool, sauna and al fresco Jacuzzi should do the trick. Further from your base, you'll meet the resident gauchos on their ranches, trek to glaciers, lakes, and magma formations, and horseback ride to explore the park – and, if you're lucky, see condors or eagles – from the peaks. And there's no need to worry about throwing yourself into the action straight after your big day: you'll work up to it with three nights at the Lastarria Boutique Hotel in Santiago, sipping cocktails, lounging by the pool and taking in the local culture.

FOR COLOURFUL VISTAS

Say 'min ga la ba' ('good morning') to your spiritual side at the golden Shwedagon Pagoda in Rangoon – just the first holy building you'll spot on your quest across Burma. In Mandalay, you'll discover a tome that leaves *War & Peace* in the shade: the world's largest book, carved into 729 five-foot-high stone slabs. And modern Burma is just a train ride away in Shwe Nyaung, home to the markets and floating villages of Inle Lake. For all-out adventure, trek through the hills to the villages of the Pa-O people.
