



# BAGLIONI MILAN: GATEWAY TO THE NORTH

Milan's newest luxury property, Casa Baglioni Milan, is scheduled for opening in January 2023. Positioned among the fashionable galleries of the central Brera district and with design from leading Milanese architects, Spagnulo & Partners, it seeks to express all the qualities that Milan has become known for - style, élan and exclusivity. And, from the social spaces and elegant accommodation to the wine cellar and Michelinstarred restaurant, you can expect the finest in Italian artistry.

Think lighting designed by Panzeri, custom wallpaper by Rubelli and handmade features by the local poetic designer Gala Rotelli. The accommodation is a special highlight. All herringbone floors and satin-finish brass, it's delightfully evocative of Milan's 1960s golden age, with suite upgrades mixing in private terraces and views of the city's skyline.

# CULINARY ADVENTURES IN ATLANTIC CANADA

From fresh lobster and freshly shucked oysters to craft breweries and boutique wineries, the four provinces of Atlantic Canada – New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island – are, in many ways, the unsung heros of Canadian food and drink. Below, you'll find a tasty selection of the very best culinary experiences the region has to offer. From lighthouse picnics to oyster shucking, it's the perfect inspiration to transform your Atlantic Canada holiday into a foodie's dream. Prepare to tuck in.

#### Caviar tasting on the Saint John River, New Brunswick

Departing from Saint John on the shores of the Bay of Fundy, join local guides for a unique chance to participate in a commercial fishing trip, heading out in search of shoals of long Atlantic sturgeon – the source of this New Brunswick favourite. Along the way, you'll learn about the company's aquaculture and the process that goes into producing caviar, which you'll then have the chance to taste, washed down with a glass of champagne, of course.

#### Lighthouse picnics, Newfoundland & Labrador

Venturing south from St. John's on the popular Irish Loop driving route, be sure to stop off at Ferryland Lighthouse - a place transformed by local Jill Curran, whose grandfather was once keeper. With a lunch basket including freshly squeezed lemonade, chutney-glazed ham, a brie sandwich served on bread baked in the lighthouse itself, and followed up with a delicious dessert - perhaps a cranberry scone with orange butter - this is a truly delicious way to take in some of Atlantic Canada's finest views. Breathe in the salty sea air and, with luck, watch on as whales pass by below.

#### Culinary highlights in Halifax, Nova Scotia

Whether you're starting or finishing your journey in Halifax, make sure you join the team from Taste Halifax Food & Beer Tours to take in the best of the local dining scene. From private local charcuterie and spirit tasting to sampling locals-favourite donairs - a type of meatfilled pita - this is the ideal introduction to urban dining, Atlantic Canada-style. Along the way, expect the likes of lobster mac & cheese washed down with locally inspired cocktails, and delicious seafood chowder and oysters served with Nova Scotian wine and craft beer.

#### Oyster shucking, Prince Edward Island

Prince Edward Island oysters are reputed to be among the best in the world. Driving along the island's picturesque east coast, you'll, stop off in the seaside town of Cardigan to meet local fisherman Jim Conohan. Settle in to hear his tales of life on the sea, then learn to tong and size oysters, before Jim teaches you the ageold art of shucking.

Whichever season you decide upon, our specialists are on hand to help you plan. And, to get you started, they've picked out just a few of the province's highlights below.

#### Calgary

Although welcomingly modern on the surface, and with a burgeoning food and craft brewery scene, Alberta's largest city wears its Old West past with pride. It's all played out at a working historic town in Heritage Park and on a staggering scale at the annual Calgary Stampede – a vibrant celebration of rodeo culture.

#### Edmonton

Far more than just a civilised rest stop among the province's great outdoors, Alberta's delightful capital is a destination in its own right. Venture in among its modern and early-20th-century architecture to find chic boutiques and restaurants joined by excellent museums and theatres that, each year, host a fringe festival that's second only to Edinburgh.

#### **Jasper National Park**

In Jasper, don't miss the mighty expanse of the Athabasca Glacier, the otherworldly blue of Maligne Lake and the thundering rivers that crash into cascading waterfalls. Potential sightings of grizzlies and moose add further intrigue and Jasper Town, with its railway-frontier heritage, is the perfect spot to base yourself.

#### Lake Louise

In a province famed for its glistening bodies of water, picking just one out speaks to the great beauty of Lake Louise. Its impossibly turquoise waters are ringed by a natural amphitheatre of mountains, glaciers and forest - views taken in by its iconic property, the castle-like Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise.

#### **Banff National Park**

Beyond the alpine-village charm of Banff town lies a wilderness protected by what is Canada's oldest national park. Here, hikers and bikers delight in the quiet alpine beauty of its wildflower meadows, glacial Lake Minnewanka and the stern grandeur of its rugged canyons and the ever-present Rocky Mountains while keeping eyes peeled for roaming elk and bears.

#### Icefields Parkway

While Alberta is criss-crossed by ultra-scenic roads, the Icefields Parkway stands out as one of North America's greatest highways. On its 230km route between Lake Louise and Jasper, it maps everything from giant glaciers and high mountain passes to gurgling rivers and serene lakes.

# ARIZONA: BEYOND THE GRAND CANYON

Wexas specialist Keely Roberts looks beyond Arizona's headline-grabbing poster child to discover a rich tapestry of natural beauty, tribal nations and thriving culture. It's all found among a wild geography of red-rock buttes and cactidotted deserts. Indeed, a drive through Arizona is a conversation with Americana itself, and we've picked out a few talking points below.

#### **Phoenix**


Although the stars above Arizona's wild remotes might give it a run for its money, the city of Phoenix offers the state's indisputably brightest lights. As America's fifth-largest city, it's a thriving metropolis in the desert, bristling with cultural intrigue. Alongside a full complement of theatres, symphony halls and opera houses, you'll be treated to some of the finest Southwestern and Mexican food around. Think mouthwatering tamales and tacos. It also invites in the state's heritage and great outdoors, with the superb Desert Botanical Garden and the excellent Heard Museum, selfdescribed as the world's pre-eminent presentation of American Indian art.

#### Sedona

With its great red sandstone formations piercing the big Arizona sky in a series of cathedral-like spires, it's no surprise that Sedona has long attracted a near-religious level of reverence. And that's not just among new-age spiritualists, with Jeep tours, hikes and hot-air balloon rides offering outdoors lovers truly moving views of its otherworldly landscape. Return to the art galleries and gourmet restaurants of its welcoming town, watched over by those omnipresent red cliffs.

#### Canyon de Chelly National Monument

For five millennia, people have called the rugged gorges of Canyon de Chelly home. And, you'll quickly see









why, with its beautifully barren ochre crags offset with surprising hidden-valley verdure that's still farmed by the Navajo people to this day. The landmark, 800-foottall Spider Rock spire and its rippling canyon surrounds are an obvious highlight, as are the thousand-year-old White House Ruins – ancient dwellings built by Ancestral Puebloans in around 1060 AD – but look a little closer and you'll discover unique prehistoric rock art, too.

#### Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park

Quite literally, this is the Old West of the silver screen, with Monument Valley's towering buttes having starred in everything from The Lone Star Ranger and Billy the Kid to a litany of John Wayne classics. In among these sandstone towers, you'll also discover Navajo beliefs that exist to this today, with members of the Navajo Nation -America's largest tribe - offering insightful guided tours. There's even evidence of the ancient Puebloan people who called this place home centuries ago.

#### Lake Powell

A labyrinthine series of flooded canyons, Lake Powell's crisp blue dramatically contrasts with the region's red rock to create a stunningly Martian landscape. Then, after exploring its rabbit warren of waterways on boating, Jet-Skiing and hiking adventures, there's plenty more in its surroundings. Glen Canyon Dam is an engineering

marvel. Walking through Antelope Canyon's rippled slot maze is like stepping onto another planet. And, Horseshoe Bend is a natural treasure, where the mighty Colorado River coils back on itself, beset by great, 1,000-foot cliffs.

#### Scottsdale

Something of an oasis town in the desert, Scottsdale is the perfect end to an Arizona adventure. Here, worldclass resorts and spas are on hand to soothe after a few days on the road, while golf courses and a walkable old town of boutiques, restaurants and galleries offer a different kind of therapy. However, if you haven't quite had your fill of exploration, there are winding hiking and biking trails along the red-rock buttes of Papago Park.

#### **Grand Canyon**

As Arizona's star turn, this UNESCO-listed site and natural wonder of the world needs little introduction. But, it's worth mentioning that there's plenty of different ways to appreciate it, depending on your tastes. Drives along its southern rim offer magnificently varied overviews and, perhaps crucially, iconic sunsets. Hikes along the rim - or even strenuous ones to the canyon floor - bring you right among its layered rocks, while helicopter flights offer a full, aerial appreciation of the canyon's sheer magnitude.



#### Blue Train

Having begun life in the 1920s, the Blue Train is South Africa's oldest-running luxury rail service. It's a unique heritage carried on to this day, with private berths dressed in polished wood panelling, marbleand-gold en suites and goose-down beds, available as doubles or twins. Upgrades even feature a butler service and soaking bathtubs. It's an elegant aesthetic that continues into the train's pair of lounges, where afternoon tea and fine South African sherries are served up to picture-window views. However, it's the dining that impresses most, with five-course banquets spanning from Karoo lamb to Knysna oysters. It's all informed by the train's route - an overnight journey between Pretoria to Cape Town with stops for expert-led excursions. Expect wine tastings, pauses at pretty colonial towns and diamond-rush landscapes.

#### Rovos Rail

If you're looking for a step up, Rovos Rail is Africa's most luxurious train. The Edwardian dining cars feature button-leather seats, the lounge car hosts wingback chairs and the berths are immaculate in darkwood elegance, complete with tiled en suites and a mini-bar stocked with beverages of your choosing. 

In search of polar bears, birds and beluga whale's in Arctic Canada's wild remotes.

For most destinations, the chance of just one worldclass wildlife experience is enough. But, in the province of Manitoba in Canada's longitudinal centre, its northern sub-Arctic wilderness offers no fewer than three. In short, this is one of the best places in the world to spot polar bears, the oh-so-adorable beluga whales and some 285 species of birds, from eagles to owls.

Then, head out in Zodiac boats onto the frigid waters of Hudson Bay to search for the inimitable beluga whale. These extremely social creatures live in pods that can reach into the hundreds. What's more, their famed bulbous forehead is wonderfully flexible, meaning they can make different facial expressions. Just don't forget to also look skywards for snowy owls, falcons and even that great icon of North America - the bald eagle.

Each night, you'll bed down in an atmospheric log cabin, relaxing by an open fire and enjoying the best in Canadian hospitality. Seal River Heritage Lodge is a particular highlight. This early entrant into the National Geographic Unique Lodges of the World collection is a further flight hop from Churchill, bringing you deeper into the Manitoban wilds for truly isolated wildlife experiences. 

# SAFARIS IN AUSTRALIA

Alongside their reputation for fine wines and glorious scenery, South Australia and Western Australia are home to some of the country's most iconic wildlife encounters. Below, we pick out the best of them, showcased across two different safaris, taking in some of Australia's wildest regions.

### The wildlife of Western Australia

From the deserts of the far north to the woodlands and wildflowers of the south, wildlife is everywhere in Western Australia. Home to an incredible 70 per cent of Australia's mammals, with 25 species endemic to the state, you've just got to know where to look.

### Perth & surrounds

According to the World Wildlife Fund, Perth might just be the wildlife capital of the world. A strange notion, perhaps, for a modern and vibrant beachside city, but not when you consider that, within its verdant limits, you'll find 2,100 plant species, 15 amphibian species and 156 native birds, with seasonal influxes from visiting seabirds and migrating shorebirds as well. Then, along the city's Swan River, you might spot everything from islanddwelling kangaroos to black swans and wild dolphins. And, from mid-August to November there's prime whalewatching to be enjoyed off the city's 19 beaches, while to the south, the likes of Rockingham offer more close-up encounters. Think Seal Island kayaking trips, penguin cruises and even the chance to swim with dolphins.





### Rottnest Island

Just a short ferry ride from Perth, the picture-perfect island of Rottnest is something of a natural paradise. With only car-free roads to navigate, and bikes as the main form of transport, myriad species have made their home among its quiet coves and sandy bays. Spend a day exploring its coastlines and you're likely to see colonies of long-nose fur seals, catch glimpses of playful dolphins, spot shoals of tropical fish darting between coral reefs and come face-to-face with the island's star turn - the quokka. These inquisitive marsupials, found only in WA, are delightfully cute, lighting up the island with their friendly demeanor and ever-so-cheeky smiles.

# Ningaloo Reef

Some 1,200 kilometres to the north of Perth lies Ningaloo Reef. And, while it's easily accessible via a short flight to Exmouth, this spectacular region is like entering another world. On the coast, great sweeps of pristine white sand slope gently down to an impossibly clear sea, which in turn gives way to the world's largest fringing coral reef. Spanning more than 160 miles, this

### Eyre Peninsula

Close to the border with Western Australia, this off-thebeaten-track gem is well worth making time for. Where the ocean meets the outback, there's the chance to swim with dolphins and sealions on one day, and seek out emus, kangaroos and koalas the next. Join a cycling tour or safari to take in the best of it, joining some of the best guides in the business who'll bring it all to life.

# Flinders Ranges

A five-hour drive north of Adelaide, via the Clare Valley wine region, the remote Flinders Ranges is a rugged home to the likes of grey-fronted honeyeaters, Lake Eyre dragons, wedge-tailed eagles and the rare yellow-footed rock wallaby, now making its comeback following a concerted rewilding programme.
